BVNS remains committed to advancing the profession; training small animal interns, internal medicine residents and students from many universities.

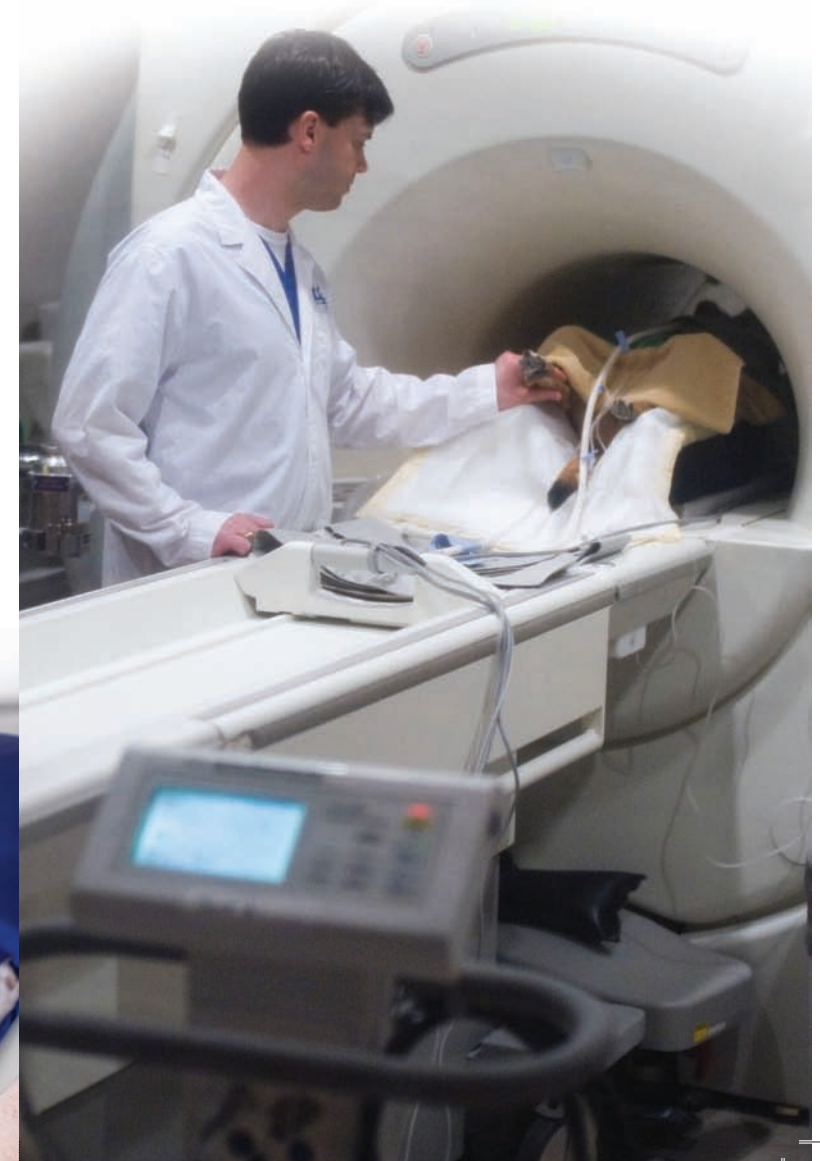

Our Expansion is Complete

Bush Veterinary Neurology Service (BVNS) has expanded with the completion of a new 3600 square foot wing on the second floor of The LifeCentre. Our facility includes a 1.5 T MRI, helical CT scanner, advanced neurosurgical suite, electrophysiology and procedure room, complete in-house laboratory, neurology treatment and nursing care ward and 5 examination rooms.



Greater Access for Patients

BVNS has expanded its professional staff which means we have even greater capacity to receive cases. In addition to a growing residency program, we welcome Dr. Peter Early, ACVIM (Neurology), staff neurologist at North Carolina State University. With a special interest in spinal stabilization and neurosurgery, Dr. Early will spend 25% of his time teaching and seeing cases at BVNS. Fully staffed on Saturdays, we see scheduled appointments, perform surgery and can also accommodate emergencies.

We pride ourselves on being available to you 24/7, as we know how much you and your patients benefit by direct access to one of our medical staff at all times.
